



**RESOLUTION - N° 004**  
**July 18th, 2022**

For the purpose in which the **2022 PAN AMERICAN INLINE SPEED SKATING CHAMPIONSHIP, IN THE JUNIOR, INTERMEDIATE (TRANSITION) AND SENIOR CATEGORIES OF CLUBS AND NATIONS**, to be held in Ibagué (Colombia) from September the 8<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>.

The president of **World Skate America** and the chairman of the Speed Technical Commission, in use of their legal, statutory powers and;

**CONSIDERING:**

- That the Pan American Calendar 2022 foresees the organization of the **IN THE MINOR, INTERMEDIATE (TRANSITION) AND SENIOR CATEGORIES OF CLUBS AND NATIONS**, in the city of Ibagué, Colombia, from September 8<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
  - That it is the duty of the WSA to promote the massive practice of skating in America.
  - That it is the commitment of the Executive Committee of the WSA to prepare events of a Continental nature.
  - That it is the duty of the WSA to regulate all events on the continental calendar of all disciplines of roller skating.
  - That the **2022 PAN AMERICAN SPEED SKATING CHAMPIONSHIP, IN THE CATEGORIES** established for **NATIONS**, is a qualifier for the Santiago de Chile 2023 Pan American Games and the San Salvador 2023 Central American and Caribbean Games.

**DETERMINES**

**ARTICLE 1. CALL**

Summon all the Clubs and Nations of the countries of the American Continent, that are affiliated to the **WSA**, to the **2022 PAN AMERICAN SPEED SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS, IN THE JUNIOR, INTERMEDIATE (TRANSITION) AND SENIOR CATEGORIES OF CLUBS AND NATIONS**, organized by the Colombian Skating Federation to be held in Colombia, in the City of IBAGUÉ, from SEPTEMBER 08 to 18, 2022.

## ARTICLE 2. REGULATIONS

The competition regulations that apply in the **World Skate America WSA Speed Skating** events are those approved by the World Skate (WS) – Speed Technical Commission (STC), in force on the date of the events.

## ARTICLE 3. PARTICIPANTS

The events of the World Skate America may be for Clubs and National Teams, which may compete together, but will be classified separately.

**ARTICLE 5. NATIONS CATEGORY**

**PARAGRAPH 1.** National Teams may participate in both junior and senior categories in men and women.

**PARAGRAPH 2.** To determine the age of Club athletes, the date of December 31, 2022 will be taken.

**PARAGRAPH 4.** Countries may participate with a maximum of 16 athletes: eight (8) ladies and eight (8) men in the youth and senior category.

**PARAGRAPH 5.** The limit of participants in the competition for speed and long-distance events in the youth and Major Nations category will be as follows:

**PARAGRAPH.** The registration of the participating athletes will be made only in the official form; which must be fully filled out, with category, full names, Identity document number and date of birth, delegate(s) (see article 19, numeral 2) and coach. Form that is not fully completed will not be accepted.

**ARTICLE 8. CLASSIFICATION AND POINTS**

There will be a classification by Clubs and by National Teams, which will be made according to the general medal table, by category and group, as contemplated by the WS-STC regulations for the year 2022.



First place in the Pan American Speed Skating Championship will go to whoever obtains the highest number of Gold medals. If there is a tie in the number of Gold medals, the highest number of Silver medals will be taken into account; If the tie in Gold and Silver medals persists, the highest number of Bronze medals will be taken into account; If the tie continues in the medal tables, the score obtained in each of the tests by category and group will be taken into account, starting from fourth position as follows:

For the general classification of the Clubs and National Teams in the Pan American Speed Skating Championship, the same criteria will be followed.

**PARAGRAPH.** The position in the Pan American Speed Skating Championship for those who do not obtain medals will be made taking into account the score awarded from position (4) four to (9) nine, for each test in each category and branch, according to the table previous.

**ARTICLE 9. SCHEDULE.**

**PARAGRAPH 1.** At the award ceremony, athletes may not appear with caps, skates, glasses or any other clothing alluding to their sponsor or brand. They must present themselves with the official lycra and their competition skates.

**PARAGRAPH 2.** During the award ceremony, the athlete who does not show up on the third call and after waiting for a period of (2) two minutes, WILL LOSE his medal and the points obtained in said race.

### **ARTICLE 11. CLASIFICATION FOR THE PAN AMERICAN, SANTIAGO 2023**

In accordance with the classification manual approved by the WSA and Panam Sport, this event will qualify for the 2023 Pan American Games in Santiago de Chile in the modalities of speed and distance, granting 18 quotas in each gender for the participating WSA member countries. in this event with A NATIONAL SELECTION, according to the following parameters:

**PARAGRAPH 1.** Since CHILE is the Host Country of the Santiago 2023 Games, it has a fixed quota of two athletes per gender, but they must participate in this qualifying event.

**PARAGRAPH 2.** The classification will be based on the results of the speed and long-distance ladder of the senior Nations category, for those athletes who manage to be in the first 9 places of the respective individual ladder by modality and by gender.

**PARAGRAPH 3.** Each country may obtain a maximum of two quotas per gender and their classification will be nominal.

**PARAGRAPH 4.** When an NOC does not confirm the acceptance of the qualified athlete's quota, the WSA will reassign this quota to the next best placed athlete, who was not qualified, may be from the same country or correspond to an athlete from another country.

## ARTICLE 12. CENTRAL AMERICAN AND CARIBBEAN CLASSIFICATION 2023

In accordance with the classification manual approved by the WSA and Caribe Sports, this event will qualify for the Central American and Caribbean Games San Salvador 2023 in the modalities of speed and distance, granting quotas in each gender for the WSA member countries that participate in this event with ONE NATIONAL SELECTION, in accordance with the regulatory parameters.

**PARAGRAPH 1.** It is clear that the quotas to be obtained will be defined and announced once the Technical Manual for the Central American and Caribbean Games to be held in San Salvador 2023 is approved.

**PARAGRAPH 2.** El Salvador, as the host country for this event, will have a fixed quota for its athletes, but they must participate in this qualifying event.



**PARAGRAPH 3.** The classification will be based on the results of the speed and long-distance ladder of the senior Nations category, for those athletes who manage to be in the first 9 places of the respective individual ladder by modality and by gender.

**PARAGRAPH 4.** Each country will be able to obtain their quotas by gender and their classification will be nominal.

**PARAGRAPH 5.** When an NOC does not confirm the acceptance of the qualified athlete's quota, the WSA will reassign this quota to the next best placed athlete, who was not qualified, may be from the same country or correspond to an athlete from another country.

**ARTÍCULO 13. RANKING FOR THE CLASSIFICATION TO THE PAN AMERICAN AND CENTRAL AMERICAN AND CARIBBEAN GAMES 2023.**

The classification ladder for the Pan American Games in Santiago de Chile 2023 and the Central American and Caribbean Games in San Salvador 2023 will be established with the following scoring system, in the Women's Major Nations category:

**ARTICLE 14. DIAMETER OF WHEELS**

By order of the Technical Speed Committee of the World Skate America WSA, the diameter allowed for these categories is established as follows:

**PARAGRAPH.** Failure to comply with this provision will result in the athlete being removed from the competition.

## **ARTICLE 15. ACCIDENT INSURANCE**

The WORLD SKATE AMERICA WSA and the COLOMBIAN SKATING FEDERATION do not assume any responsibility for accidents that may occur during the development of the championship, for this reason, each athlete, delegate, coach and judges must have their current international accident insurance, health policies, EPS, prepaid health, among others. Similarly, the foreign athlete participating in the championship must have current insurance that covers any risk of sports accident, leaving the delegation under the responsibility of the respective Delegate of each participating Team.

**PARAGRAPH 1.** Considering the high level of accidents that occurs in this modality, the use of protective gloves will be required for the lower categories, which must be made of leather or resistant material on the palmar side and soft material on the side of the face. dorsal. In no way, these may contain metallic materials, nor those that threaten the integrity of the other participants.

## **ARTICLE 16. INTERCOMS**

For all categories, the use of intercom equipment during the different races is prohibited.

## ARTICLE 18. CLAIMS

According to the provisions of WORLD SKATE, any claim made will be made only to THE MEMBERS OF THE WSA TECHNICAL COMMISSION, which must be submitted within fifteen (15) minutes of having read the official result and only when has violated the judging manual or regulation, canceling the stipulated sums. Consequently, the WSA Technical Commission will review the claim and if the violation of the regulations is determined, it will be accepted and the respective sanction will be applied, in this case the consigned value will be returned, otherwise they will go to the funds of the WSA. The claim must be presented exclusively by the accredited delegate of the Club or the Country.

**ARTICLE 20. SPECIAL GUIDELINES REGARDING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC**

Due to the contingency due to the COVID-19 Sanitary, Social and Ecological Emergency, decreed by the National Government and the special provisions that deal with the development of sports activity, the following specifications are established that will be mandatory.

Only registered athletes may enter the stage according to the call schedule, and a maximum of one coach, one delegate and one applied science professional per Club.

Access to the public, family members or companions will be allowed in accordance with the CAPACITY PROTOCOLS ordered by the competent authorities on stage.

The Colombian Skating Federation is the only entity that will authorize the judging team, commissioner, paramedic, assistant, logistics and communications for the given scenario.

Skaters, Clubs, Leagues or Nations must take into account that, given the circumstances of the current health emergency, the Colombian Skating Federation may suspend, postpone or extend the development and execution of this event considered as the PAN AMERICAN SKATING CHAMPIONSHIP OF SPEED 2022, in the event that, by provision of the National Government, the prohibition of sports activity is determined or a new MANDATORY PREVENTIVE ISOLATION is decreed.

Taking into account the competition system that will be used in this 2022 PAN AMERICAN SPEED SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS, it is required that all authorized assistants, skaters, technicians, delegates, applied science professionals, judges, commissioners, and support personnel who participate they must comply with the Biosafety Protocols established by the Colombian Skating Federation, and must present the CARNET WITH VACCINATION SCHEME Due to the contingency due to the Sanitary Emergency, related to the COVID19 pandemic, decreed by the Government of Colombia.



**ARTICLE 21. VALIDITY** - This resolution is effective from the date of its issuance.

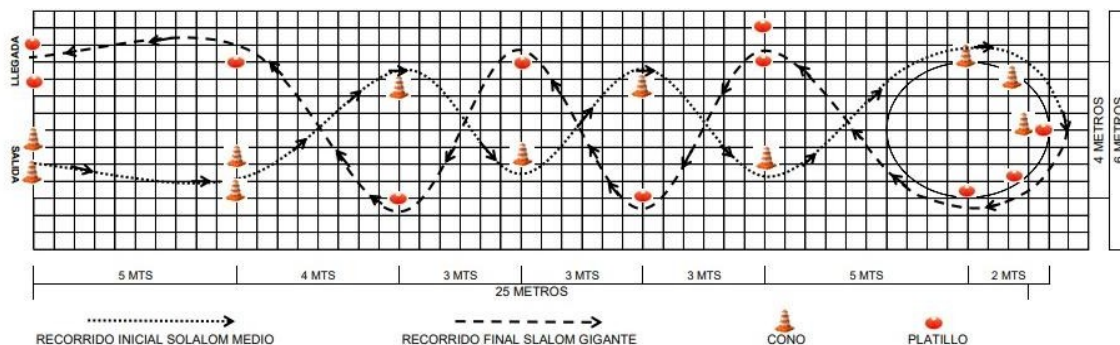
