



## **RESOLUTION No. 002**

June 20<sup>th</sup> 2022

For the purpose in which the 2022 **PAN AMERICAN ARTISTIC SKATING CHAMPIONSHIP, AMATEUR CATEGORY**, is convened and regulated, to be held in the city of Cancun, Mexico, from August 26 to 31, 2022.

The president of the World Skate America and the chairman of the technical commission of artistic skating in use of their legal, statutory powers and;

### **CONSIDERING**

- That the 2022 Pan American Calendar provides for the 2022 PAN AMERICAN ARTISTIC SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS, AMATEUR CATEGORY.
- That it is the duty of World Skate America to regulate all events on the official calendar of all skating modalities.
- That it is the duty of World Skate America to promote the development and popularization of the artistic skating discipline in the American continent.

### **DETERMINES**

#### **ARTICLE 1 - CALL**

Summon and regulate how it is actually done, the 2022 PAN AMERICAN ARTISTIC SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS AMATEUR CATEGORY.

## **PARAGRAPH 1 - LEVELS AND CATEGORIES**

- Club Championship, amateur level at three different levels, tot, mini, Espoir, cadets, youth, junior and senior categories.

In this club event, the technical regulations contemplated in the World Skate América Artistic 2022 regulation for amateur category, currently published on the website, will be competed.

**PARAGRAPH 2** - No athlete can register in two different categories or efficiencies; this means each athlete may have only one participation.

**PARAGRAPH 3** - Athletes who participate in the promotional Club Pan American Championship cannot participate in this tournament.

## **ARTICLE 2 - DATES**

These dates may change one day before or after the stipulated dates depending on the number of registered athletes.

- Amateur Club Championship August 26-31, 2022.

## **ARTICLE 3 - ORGANIZATION**

World Skate America will coordinate the organization of the event with the support of the Mexican Roller-Skating Federation in administrative and logistical aspects, and the artistic skating technical committee in technical sports aspects.

## **ARTICLE 4 - PARTICIPANTS**

The athletes of the clubs, schools, teams that belong to the national Federations affiliated to WS and have their respective endorsement may participate in the event.

## **ARTICLE 5° REGISTRATION LIMIT**

There is no restriction of registered athletes by category, efficiency and gender.

Coaches: for the club event, each club will have the right to register up to three (3) coaches plus one (1) delegate.

## **ARTICLE 6 - SANCTIONS AND TRANSITIONAL DISABILITIES**

The Club, association, Confederation and/or Federation that registers athletes, who do not show up for the event or who while registered, do not show up for a certain test, will be sanctioned or disqualified as stipulated by the WSA.

The payment of the penalty is essential for the club/federation to recover the right to participate in another competition.

**PARAGRAPH 1** - They will be exempt from the sanctions described in article 7, the athletes, clubs, Confederations and/or federations that:

- Submit justification accredited by an official doctor verified by the Federation to which they belong.
- Present a positive Covid-19 test when traveling to the event.
- For reasons of force majeure, duly verified by the WSA Artistic Skating Technical Commission and authorized by the WSA President.

**PARAGRAPH 2** - In the event that an organization or athlete is exempt from the established disabilities, it is not exempt from the payment of economic obligations acquired with the organization and the WSA, corresponding to the registration of the athlete and/or club/federation to the event, as the case may be.

**PARAGRAPH 3** - Athletes and/or clubs that incur in any of the issues described in this article, will have three (3) calendar days following the completion of the event, to present in writing the reasons they had to justify their absence from the event. with the respective proofs to the email [inscripcionespanamericano@gmail.com](mailto:inscripcionespanamericano@gmail.com) .

## **ARTICLE 7 - AWARDS**

The athletes who occupy the first five (5) places in each test, by branch and modality, will be awarded as follows: 1 gold, 2 silver and 2 bronze.

## **ARTICLE 8 - DRAWS AND STARTING ORDERS**

Starting orders will be made electronically and will be published in advance for review and correction prior to the briefing.

## ARTICLE 9 - REGISTRATION AND GUARANTEES

With World Skate America disposition, the inscriptions of the clubs and nations must be sent through the Federation and/or Confederation to which they belong; Registrations sent individually by each club or association will not be taken into account.

The registration must be sent into the established dates in article 12 by email [inscripcionespanamericano@gmail.com](mailto:inscripcionespanamericano@gmail.com).

The form published on the World Skate America page must be used, without converting to PDF or image. Different formats will not be taken into account.

**PARAGRAPH 1** - The ORIGINAL form, duly signed by the club and Federation, must be presented on the day of accreditation. Without this document, accreditation will not be possible. Incomplete registrations submitted in a different format will be deemed not received.

**PARAGRAPH 2** - For the amateur club event, it will be notified later if it will be necessary to fill out a form. If necessary, the document of the order of the technical elements in two copies will be attached at the time of registration.

**PARAGRAPH 3** - The music of the athletes MUST be uploaded according to the modality to be published. It must be recorded at 320 and in MP3 format. The name of each file must be: skater's name, skater's last name, category\_ Modality\_ Program.

**PARAGRAPH 4** - The club, school, team or association that is not represented at the briefing, by accredited delegate before the WSA, may not make claims at the event.



## ARTICLE 10° INSCRIPTION FEES

The value of ordinary and extraordinary registrations will be:

**PARAGRAPH 1** - The inscription fees of the Championship must be paid in cash in US dollars, by the respective delegate before entering the briefing of the event (according to the detailed schedule to be published).

## ARTICLE 11 - CLAIMS

World Skate rules will be followed.

## ARTICLE 12 - AUTHORITIES OF THE EVENT

- The highest authority is the technical direction of the event, which will be in charge of the person designated by the president of World Skate America.
- The highest judging authority will be the technical officials.
- The highest disciplinary authority will be the Disciplinary Commission of the event, which will be made up of the referee judge of the event, one of the delegates of the Pan American Commission present and a representative designated by the Host Federation of the event.
- The maximum administrative authority will be the Steering Committee of the event, headed by the president of World Skate America.

### **ARTICLE 13 - CANCELLATION OR MODIFICATION OF TESTS**

Only the World Skate America artistic skating technical committee may modify or cancel a certain trial that does not meet the conditions of the contest, due to space on the stage, lack of time, competitive level, guarantees or unforeseen delays in programming.

### **ARTICLE 14 - BRIEFING**

The informative meeting of the event will take place on Friday, August 26, 2022 at the place and time that the organization of the event has for this purpose and that will be announced in the official invitation. For this meeting, the presence of at least one of the coaches per club that appears inscribed in the respective forms and the judges that have been summoned is requested.

**PARAGRAPH 1** - Once the briefing is over, the judges' meeting will take place in the same room.

### **ARTICLE 15 - LIABILITY IN ACCIDENTS**

World Skate America and the Mexican Roller-Skating Federation are not responsible for accidents that may occur during the event, which is why all skaters must have valid medical and/or accident insurance, ORIGINAL documents that must be presented at the time of the respective accreditations.



## **ARTICLE 16 - VALIDITY**

This resolution is effective from the date of its issuance. Given in Bogotá city, on the twentieth (20) day of June 2022.
