The 2023 season is already alive within World Skate America with a calendar full of intense activities that are essential to better our sport.

Gaining full knowledge of the 2023 Regulations, as well as clarifications on judging are part of the purpose of the WSA. Helping all Federation members to be up-to-date and familiar with the intense work carried out by the officials, along with the work and understanding of the coaches, athletes and managers are goals of WSA.

For this reason the Continental Artistic Skating Seminar has been scheduled, aimed at judges, coaches and athletes. The seminar will be held in the beautiful city of Cartagena, Colombia from February 15-19, 2023.

The training sessions will be led by Nicola Genchi, chairman of the World Skate Artistic Technical Commission, the foremost judging authority in the world. Next to him will be Gabriela Otten, a member of the World Skate Artistic Technical Commission. Coaches Pedro Romero and Enrique Demata, will offer their input on their extensive experience with great results in the growth of the sport, especially in Colombia.

The agenda will include the Rollart 2023 Regulations, theory and practical of all the disciplines, including Free Skating, Pairs, Solo Dance, Couple Dance, Show, Precision and Quartet. There will also be heavy focus on QOEs and Components.

In addition, the WSA Seminar will help aspiring international judges and technical specialists in the different disciplines to update their knowledge and prepare for their respective exams.
