



RESOLUTION N° 004

April 25th, 2023

To invite and regulate the PAN AMERICAN ARTISTIC SKATING PROMOTIONAL SHOW AND PRECISION CUP FOR CLUBS 2023, to take place at the city of Rionegro, Colombia on August 6th, 2023.

The President of World Skate America, in use of his legal attributions, and;

CONSIDERING

- That the Pan American Calendar 2023 foresees the organization PAN AMERICAN ARTISTIC SKATING PROMOTIONAL SHOW AND PRECISION CUP FOR CLUBS 2023.
- That one of the duties of World Skate America is to regulate all the events of the official calendar for all the disciplines of skating.

RESOLVES:

ARTICLE 1 - ANNOUNCEMENT

To Invite and regulate, the PAN AMERICAN ARTISTIC SKATING PROMOTIONAL SHOW AND PRECISION CUP FOR CLUBS 2023.

PARAGRAPH 1 – CATEGORIES AND EVENTS

SHOW (CLUBS)

EVENT:

LARGE GROUP: From 16 (sixteen) to 30 (thirty) skaters (max 4 reserves).

CATEGORIES:

ESPOIRE

Program time: 3.30-4.00 minutes +/-10 seconds. Time begins with first movement.

JUNIOR & SENIOR

Program time: 4.00-4.30 minutes +/-10 seconds. Time begins with first movement.

EVENT:

SMALL GROUP: From 6(six) to 12(twelve) skaters (maximum 2 reserves).

CATEGORIES:

ESPOIRE

Program time: 3.30-4.00 minutes +/-10 seconds. Time begins with the first movement.

JUNIOR & SENIOR

Program time: 4.00-4.30 minutes +/-10 seconds. Time begins with the first movement.

EVENT:

QUARTETS: 4 (four) skaters (maximum 1 reserve).

Program time: 3.00 minutes +/-10 seconds.

Time begins with first movement.

CATEGORIES:

ESPOIRE: skaters must be at least 8 years old before January 1st of the year of the competition, 13 years old until December 31st of the year of the competition.

JUNIOR: Skaters must be at least 12 years old before January 1st of the year of competition, and not yet 19 years old until December 31st of the year of competition.

SENIOR: Skaters must be at least 12 years old by January 1st of the year of competition.

PRECISION

SINGLE EVENT. A team of 16 (sixteen) skaters with a maximum of 4 (four) reserves.

CATEGORIES:

ESPOIRE: team members must be at least 8 years old and a maximum of 13 years old within the year of the competition. Skaters can choose to compete in a category higher than their age.

JUNIOR: Skaters must be at least 12 years old before January 1st of the year of the competition, and not even 19 years of age until December 31st of the year of the competition.

SENIOR: Skaters must be at least 12 years old before January 1st of the year of the competition.

PARAGRAPH 2 – TECHNICAL RULES

For this club event, the following rules will apply:

SHOW

LARGE AND SMALL GROUP EVENTS

These competitions will follow world Skate rules

QUARTETS

ESPOIRE

- One (1) line (maximum level 2).
- One (1) synchronized traveling (maximum level 1).
- One (1) creative element.

JUNIOR

- One (1) line (maximum level 3).
- One (1) synchronized traveling (maximum level 2).
- One (1) creative element.

SENIOR

- One (1) line (of any level).
- One (1) synchronized traveling (maximum level 3).
- One (1) creative element.

For technical elements requirements, levels and QOE's, and for penalties go to the World Skate Quartets 2023 regulations.

PRECISION

ESPOIRE:

Music time: 4:00 minutes +/-10 seconds (music is counted from the first movement that must begin no later than 10 seconds after it starts). It can be vocalized.

MANDATORY ELEMENTS:

- One (1) pivoting line. Maximum level 1.
- One (1) no Hold element. Maximum level 3, with additional feature Step Sequence maximum level 1.
- One (1) basic two-line intersection (no whip, box, triangle, or angular) with back-to-back preparation, with additional feature Point of Intersection. Maximum level 2.
- One (1) intersection of any type, maximum level 3, no turns or body movements at the point of intersection (the goal is correct preparation and gaps' creation).
- One (1) linear block. Maximum level 3.
- One (1) Travelling Circle that contains only connection steps or changes of direction (no weaving). Maximum level 1.
- One (1) rotational wheel. Maximum level 3.

JUNIOR:

Music time: 4:00 minutes +/- 10 seconds (music is counted from the first movement that must begin no later than 10 seconds after it starts). It can be vocalized.

MANDATORY ELEMENTS:

- One (1) line (linear element). Maximum level 4.
- One (1) no hold element. Maximum level 3 with additional feature Step Sequence maximum level 2.
- One (1) intersection with preparation and back-to-back approach of any level. It cannot have turns or body movements; the goal is learning correct preparation and approach.
- One (1) maximum intersection level 3, with additional feature Intersection point maximum level 2.
- One (1) pivoting block. Maximum level 1.
- One (1) traveling circle. Maximum level 2.
- One (1) rotational wheel. Maximum level 4.

SENIOR

Music time: 4:30 minutes +/-10 seconds (music is counted from the first movement that must begin no later than 10 seconds after it starts). It can be vocalized.

MANDATORY ELEMENTS:

- One (1) pivoting line. Maximum level 3.
- One (1) no hold element. Maximum level 4 with additional feature Step Sequence maximum level 3.
- One (1) maximum intersection level 4, with additional feature Maximum intersection point level 2.
- One (1) linear block. Maximum level 4.
- One (1) traveling wheel. Maximum level 3.
- One (1) rotational circle. Maximum level 4.
- One (1) creative intersection.

PENALTIES FOR PRECISION

For Precision penalties, refer to the World Skate Precision 2023 Regulations.

PARAGRAPH 3 - In these disciplines it is allowed for a skater to skate in a maximum of two (2) age categories during the same competition or championships. Rule 2.3 from World Skate General Rule book for 2023.

PARAGRAPH 4 - Athletes who participated in world championship, cannot participate in this championship in the same discipline.

ARTICLE 2 – DATES AND VENUE:

Tentative dates (these dates could change by one day, by request of World Skate America ATC, according to the number of skaters in each event): August 6th, 2023.

The venue for this event is Unidad Deportiva Ivan Ramiro Cordoba on 43rd st. N°50 – 200 Rionegro, Antioquia.

ARTICLE 3 - ORGANIZATION

World Skate America and Colombian Skating Federation will oversee the event administrative and logistical aspects, and the WSA Artistic Technical Committee, the technical aspects.

ARTICLE 4 - PARTICIPANTS

Athletes from World Skate America member countries are eligible to participate.

ARTICLE 5 - LIMIT OF REGISTRATION

ATHLETES: Each club can register up to 5 groups for each category and discipline.

SUPPORT PERSONNEL: there will be up to two (2) coaches and one (1) delegate free of charge. After that, extra coaches can register for a fee.

PARAGRAPH 1. Coaches and delegates registrations will be valid exclusively for this cup. Accreditation will be required for every event.

ARTICLE 6 - PENALTIES AND TEMPORARY INELIGIBILITIES

Any club, league or association with registered athletes, that do not show up to the event or that, while registered, do not show up for a particular event, will be sanctioned or disqualified as stipulated by the WSA.

The penalty payment is mandatory to regain the right to participate in another competition.

PARAGRAPH 1 Athletes, clubs, leagues or associations will be exempt from the penalties described in article 6:

- Submitting a justification letter signed by an official doctor previously verified by their National Federation.
- For reasons of force majeure, verified by the WSA Artistic Skating Technical Committee and authorized by the WSA president.

PARAGRAPH 2 In case that an organization or athlete is exempted from the established ineligibilities, it is not exonerated from the registration payment.

PARAGRAPH 3 Athletes and/or clubs, leagues or associations that engage in any of the ineligibilities described in this article, will have three (3) days after the event, to present a written justification for their non-attendance, with the supporting documents to the e-mail inscripcionespanamericano@gmail.com.

ARTICLE 7 – AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the athletes, couples or groups who occupy the first four places in each event, by gender and discipline, as follows: 1 gold, 1 silver and 1 bronze.

ARTICLE 8 – DRAWS AND SKATING ORDER

The skating order will be drawn electronically and will be published in advance for review and correction prior to the technical meeting.

ARTICLE 9 – MUSIC AND TECHNICAL CONTENT SHEET

PARAGRAPH 1 - It will be mandatory to upload the technical content sheet according to WSA instructions that each club, league or association will be addressed previous to the event. The format published on the World Skate web site will be used.

PARAGRAPH 2 – Skaters music MUST be uploaded according to WSA instructions. It must be in MP3 format at 320bpm.

ARTICLE 10 – REGISTRATIONS

The registration must be sent according to the dates established in this article by e-mail at inscripcionespanamericano@gmail.com.

Form published on the World Skate America website must be used, without converting it to PDF or image. Different formats will not be accepted.

PARAGRAPH 1 – The ORIGINAL form, duly signed, must be submitted on the accreditation process. Without this document, this process cannot be finished. Those incomplete registrations presented in a different format will be considered as not received.

PARAGRAPH 2 – Claims will not be accepted from clubs, leagues or associations whose delegates are not present at the brief meeting.

ARTICLE 11 – ENTRY FEES

The cost for the ordinary and extraordinary registrations will be

CONCEPT	ORDINARY	EXTRAORDINARY
Per Club/ league/ association	US 80	US 120
Rate per athlete for each discipline	US 50	US 70
Extra Coach Registration	US 50	US 70

PARAGRAPH 1 Registration payments must be made in cash in US dollars, or the official conversion to Colombian pesos (dollar TRM) by the delegate according to the detailed program to be published.

PARAGRAPH 2 All federations and/or Confederation that have athletes from clubs, leagues or associations participating in the Pan American Championship, must be in compliance with World Skate America's regulations.

ARTICLE 12 – COMPLAINTS

World Skate rules will be followed.

ARTICLE 13 – AUTHORITIES OF THE EVENT

- World Skate Americas President will nominate the event manager.
- The highest judging authority will be the technical officials.
- The disciplinary committee will be comprised by the event referee, one of the Pan American Commission delegates, and a representative designated by the event Host Federation.
- The maximum administrative authority will be the World Skate America's President who will be the head for the Event Management Committee.

ARTICLE 14 – EVENT MODIFICATION OR CANCELLATION

Only the World Skate America Artistic Skating Technical Committee can modify or cancel a certain event that does not comply with the competition conditions, due to rink space, lack of time, lack of competitive level, guarantees, or unforeseen delays in the programming.

ARTICLE 15 – TECHNICAL MEETING

The event technical meeting will be held at the place and time that the event organization arranges for that purpose and will be announced later. The presence of, at least, one of each team's coaches is requested for this meeting. Judges also have to attend this meeting.

PARAGRAPH 1 Once the brief meeting ends, the judges' meeting will be held in the same room.
