



RESOLUTION No. 002

April 02, 2024

By which the **PAN AMERICAN CUP OF PROMOTIONAL SHOW AND PRECISION ARTISTIC SKATING CLUBS OF 2024** is convened and regulated, to be held in the city of **IBAGUE – COLOMBIA ON JULY 10, 2024.**

The president of World Skate America, in use of his legal, statutory and;

CONSIDERING

- That the 2024 Pan American Calendar provides for the holding of the PAN AMERICAN CUP OF PROMOTIONAL SHOW AND PRECISION ARTISTIC SKATING CLUBS IN 2024.
- That it is the duty of World Skate America to regulate all events on the official calendar of all forms of skating.

SOLVE

ARTICLE 1 ° CALL

Call, as is in fact done, the PAN AMERICAN CUP OF PROMOTIONAL SHOW AND PRECISION ARTIST IC SKATING CLUBS OF 2024

PARAGRAPH 1 ° EVENTS AND CATEGORIES

SHOW (CLUBS)

Events:

LARGE GROUP: From 16 (sixteen) to 30 (thirty) skaters (maximum 4 substitutes).

ESPOIR Program time: 3.30-4.00 minutes +/-10 seconds. Time begins with the first movement.

JUNIOR AND SENIOR Program time: 4.00-4.30 minutes +/-10 seconds. Time begins with the first movement.

SMALL GROUP: From 6 (six) to 12 (twelve) skaters (maximum 2 substitutes).

ESPOIR Program time:3.30-4.00 minutes +/-10 seconds. Time begins with the first movement.

JUNIOR AND SENIOR Program time: 4.00-4.30 minutes +/-10 seconds. Time begins with the first movement.

QUARTETS: 4 (four) skaters (maximum 1 substitute).

Program time: 3.00 minutes +/-10 seconds. The beat begins with the first movement.

Categories:

ESPOIR: skaters must be at least 8 years old before January 1 of the year of the competition, 13 years old until December 31 of the year of the competition.

JUNIOR: Skaters must be at least 12 years of age by January 1 of the competition year, and not yet 19 years of age by December 31 of the competition year.

SENIOR: Skaters must be at least 12 years old by January 1 of the year of the competition.

PRECISION

Unique event. The team is made up of a minimum of 12 (twelve) and a maximum of 16 (sixteen) skaters with a maximum of 4 (four) substitutes.

categories:

ESPOIR: Team members must be at least 8 years old and at most 13 years old within the year of the competition. Skaters can choose to compete in a category above their age. Unique efficiency. Groups may include up to 25% (four skaters if the group is 16 and 3 skaters if the group is 15, 14, 13 or 12 members) of skaters up to 13 years of age competing in another age category. precision.

JUNIOR: Team members must be at least 12 years old and at most 18 years old within the year of the competition. Skaters can choose to compete in a category above their age. Unique efficiency. Groups may include up to 25% (four skaters if the group is 16 and 3 skaters if the group is 15, 14, 13 or 12) of skaters up to 18 years of age competing in another age category. precision.

SENIOR: Team members must be at least 12 years old within the year of the competition. Groups may include up to 25% (four skaters if the group is 16 and 3 skaters if the group is 15, 14, 13 or 12 members) of skaters who turn at least 12 years of age in the year of the competition. and compete in another category by age of precision

Skaters who are part of precision teams may participate in a maximum of two different age categories within the same competition.

PARAGRAPH 2º RULES - In the club event, competition will be carried out with the following technical regulations.

SHOW

LARGE AND SMALL GROUPS:

World Skate rules for competition and penalties will be followed.

QUARTETS

ESPOIR CATEGORY

- One line (maximum level 2).
- A synchronized traveling (maximum level 1).
- A creative element.

JUNIOR CATEGORY

- Canon sequence (maximum level 3).
- A synchronized traveling (maximum level 2).
- A creative element.

SENIOR CATEGORY

- Cluster sequence (of any level).
- A synchronized traveling (maximum level 3).
- A creative element.

For requirements, levels and QOE's of the technical elements and penalties, please refer to the World Skate Quartets 2024 regulations.

PRECISION

GENERAL RULES:

The use of handheld accessories is not permitted.

- No costume changes can be made during the program.
- The following limitations will be enforced:
 - ✓ No lifts are allowed in Espoir category.
 - ✓ Group lifts are not allowed in the Junior National category (only two people).
 - ✓ Acrobatic movements (crowns, back flip, etc.) performed by an individual skater are not permitted.
- At least three (3) grips of different TYPE must be presented.
- At least one of the following free skating move options must be presented during the program (see World Skate rules on Move Element), as follows –

Option A: two different movements presented by the entire team (16 skaters). For example: if the entire team executes a camel position in one part of the program and at another time the entire team executes an Ina Bauer position, this instruction will be fulfilled.

Option B: three different moves presented by at least half of the team (8 skaters). For example: 8 skaters execute Biellmann, 8 skaters execute upright extension (split) and 8 skaters execute camel (it can be at the same moment or in different passages of the choreography).

Option C: four different movements performed by groups of 4 skaters. For example: 4 skaters execute Biellmann, 4 skaters execute upright extension (split), 4 execute Spread Eagle and 4 execute camel (it can be at the same moment or in different passages of the choreography). Moves can be presented during a technical element or in transitions and must be chosen from those listed in the Free Skating Moves (fms) box of the World Skate Rules.

If the team does not present these movements, it will receive a deduction of 0.5.

- All listed elements must be presented, there being no minimum level required for each element.
- There are no limits on the number of features that can be executed on the elements, but a level higher than the maximum allowed for the category will not be granted.
- All specifications of basic requirements, features for levels and additional bonuses correspond to the World Skate 2024 rules. Bonuses may be included in those elements in which they are not limited
- The items listed can be skated in any order.
- Forward and/or backward skating can be incorporated into all elements.
- Footwork is allowed during any element

ESPOIR CATEGORY:

Music time: 4:00 minutes +/-10 seconds (the music is counted from the first movement, which must begin no later than 10 seconds after it starts). It can be vocalized.

Mandatory elements:

- 1) A Traveling element that can optionally be a circle or a wheel and that the feature can only include two different element shapes (that is, during execution it can be changed from a circle to a wheel or vice versa).
- 2) A Pivoting Line. Maximum level 2
- 3) An element without grip (No Hold). Maximum level 3, additionally they can try bonuses.

- 4) A basic intersection of two lines (no whip, box, triangle, or angle) with back to back preparation, which may include bonuses.
- 5) An Intersection of any type, maximum level 3, without bonus turns, free skating moves or body movements at the intersection point (the objective is the correct preparation and creation of the doors).
- 6) A Linear Block. Maximum level 3.
- 7) A circle Rotational Maximum level 4

JUNIOR CATEGORY:

Music time: 4:00 minutes +/- 10 seconds (the music is counted from the first movement, which must begin no later than 10 seconds after it starts). It can be vocalized.

Mandatory elements:

- 1) A Pivoting Line. Maximum level 3
- 2) An Element without grip (No Hold). Maximum level 3, additionally they can try bonuses.
- 3) A maximum level 3 Intersection with optional bonus.
- 4) An Intersection of any level, without bonus turns, free skating moves or body movements at the intersection point (the objective is the correct preparation and creation of the doors).
- 5) A Linear Block. Maximum level 4.
- 6) A Traveling Element. Maximum level 2
- 7) A Rotational circle. Maximum level 4

SENIOR CATEGORY:

Music time: 4:30 minutes +/-10 seconds (the music is counted from the first movement, which must begin no later than 10 seconds after it starts). It can be vocalized.

Mandatory elements:

- 1) A Pivoting Block. Maximum level 3.
- 2) An Element without grip (No Hold). Maximum level 3 and with optional bonus.
- 3) An Intersection without a maximum level and with an optional bonus.
- 4) A linear line. No maximum level.
- 5) A Traveling element. Maximum level 3.

- 6) A Rotational wheel. Maximum level 4.
- 7) A Move element Maximum level 3

PRECISION PENALTIES

For Precision penalties, refer to the World Skate Precision 2024 Regulations.

PARAGRAPH 3 ° - For these disciplines a skater can compete in a maximum of two (2) categories during the same competition. Refer to rule 2.3 of the World Skate General Regulations for 2023

PARAGRAPH 4 ° - Athletes who participated in world championships cannot participate in this championship in the same discipline as their participation in the world championship.

ARTICLE 2nd DATES

These dates may change one day, before or after, the stipulated dates depending on the number of registered participants): July 10, 2023.

ARTICLE 3 ° ORGANIZATION

World Skate America and the Colombian Skating Federation will be responsible for organizing the event in administrative and logistical aspects and the figure skating technical committee will be responsible for the technical sports aspects.

ARTICLE 4 ° PARTICIPANTS

Athletes who belong to clubs of the national Federations affiliated with WS may participate in the event.

ARTICLE 5 ° REGISTRATION LIMIT

- Athletes: each club may register up to five (5) groups per category and modality.
- Support staff: each club will have the right to register up to two (2) coaches plus one (1) delegate. They will be able to register an extra coach, only if they have athletes registered in more than one modality. They can enroll more support staff by paying the extra trainer fee.

PARAGRAPH 1. The accreditations of coaches and delegates registered for this cup. In each event the corresponding accreditation will be required.

ARTICLE 6 ° SANCTIONS AND TRANSITIONAL DISABILITY

The Club, league or association that registers athletes, who do not appear at the event or who, being registered, do not appear for a specific event, will be sanctioned or disqualified as stipulated by the WSA. Payment of the penalty is essential for the club/federation to regain the right to participate in another competition.

PARAGRAPH 1 ° - Athletes, clubs, leagues or associations that:

- Present justification accredited by an official doctor verified by the Federation to which you belong.
- For reasons of force majeure, duly verified by the WSA figure skating technical commission and authorized by the president of the WSA.

PARAGRAPH 2 ° - In the event that an organization or athlete is exempt from the established disabilities, it is not exonerated from the payment of the financial obligations acquired with the organization and the WSA, corresponding to the registrations of the athlete and/or club/federation to the event, as the case may be.

PARAGRAPH 3 ° - Athletes and/or clubs that incur any of the disabilities described in this article will have three (3) calendar days following the event, to present in writing the reasons they had for justify your absence from the event, with the respective evidence to the [email inscripcionesartistico@worldskateamerica.org](mailto:inscripcionesartistico@worldskateamerica.org)

ARTICLE 7th AWARD

For the club event, the athletes who occupy the first 4 places in each event, by branch and modality, will also be awarded as follows: 1 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronze.

ARTICLE 8 ° DRAWINGS AND STARTING ORDERS

Exit orders will be made using an electronic system and will be published in advance for review and correction prior to the information meeting.

ARTICLE 9 MUSIC AND TECHNICAL CONTENT SHEET

PARAGRAPH 1 - It will be mandatory to upload the technical content document according to WSA instructions that will be given to each club, league or Association. The format published on the World Skate page will be used.

PARAGRAPH 2 - The music of the programs MUST be loaded according to the modality according to WSA instructions. It must be in MP3 format at 320bpm.

ARTICLE 10 ° REGISTRATIONS AND ENDORSEMENTS

The registration must be sent according to the dates established in this article by email inscripcionesartistico@worldskateamerica.org

PARAGRAPH 1 ° - The ORIGINAL form, duly signed, must be presented on the day of accreditations. Without this document, accreditation cannot be carried out. Incomplete registrations submitted in a different format will be considered not received.

PARAGRAPH 2 ° - The club or association that is not represented at the information meeting, by its delegate duly accredited to the WSA, will not be able to make claims at the event.

ARTICLE 11 ° REGISTRATION VALUE

The values of registrations in ordinary and extraordinary periods will be the following:

PARAGRAPH 1 ° - The value of the Championship registrations must be paid in cash in US dollars, by the respective delegate before entering the event information meeting (according to a detailed schedule to be published).

PARAGRAPH 2 ° - In order for athletes from a country to participate in the Pan American Club Championship regardless of their individual, club or association participation, it is required that the Federation and/or Confederation to which they belong are in peace and safety. for all reasons with World Skate America.

ARTICLE 12 ° CLAIMS

The rules of Word Skate will be followed.

ARTICLE 13 ° EVENT AUTHORITIES

- The highest authority in the technical direction of the event will be the person designated by the president of World Skate America.
- The highest judging authority will be the technical officials.
- The highest disciplinary authority will be the Disciplinary Commission of the event, which will be made up of the referee of the event, one of the delegates of the Pan American commission present and a representative designated by the Federation Hosting the event.
- The maximum administrative authority will be the Steering Committee of the event, headed by the president of World Skate America.

ARTICLE 14 ° MODIFICATION OR CANCELLATION OF TESTS

Only the figure skating technical committee of World Skate America may modify or cancel a certain event that does not comply with the conditions of the competition, due to space on the stage, lack of time, competitive level, guarantee. or due to unforeseen delays in scheduling.

ARTICLE 15 ° INFORMATIVE MEETING

The event information meeting will take place at the place and time that the event organization provides for this purpose and that will be announced in the official invitation. For this meeting, the presence of at least one of the coaches who are registered on the respective rosters by club, league or association and the judges who have been summoned are requested.

PARAGRAPH 1 ° - Once the information meeting is concluded, in the same room the meeting of judges will proceed to be held.

ARTICLE 16 ° RESPONSIBILITY IN ACCIDENTS

World Skate America and the Colombian Skating Federation are not responsible for accidents that may occur during the event, which is why all skaters must have current medical and/or accident insurance, ORIGINAL documents that must be present. be presented at the time of the respective accreditations.

ARTICLE 17 ° VALIDITY

This resolution takes effect from the date of its issuance. Given in the city of Ibagué, on the 2° day of April 2024.
