



RESOLUTION N° 005

March 6th, 2025

To call and regulate the 2025 PAN AMERICAN CUP FOR PROMOTIONAL CLUBS IN SHOW AND PRECISION ARTISTIC SKATING to be held in the city of Buenos Aires, Argentina from July 6th, 2025.

The President of World Skate America, in use of his legal and statutory powers;

CONSIDERING

- That the 2025 Pan American Calendar provides for the holding of the 2025 PAN AMERICAN CUP FOR PROMOTIONAL CLUBS IN SHOW AND PRECISION ARTISTIC SKATING.
- That it is the duty of World Skate America to regulate all the official calendar events of all skating disciplines.

SOLVES:

ARTICLE 1 - CALL

To call and regulate, the 2025 PAN AMERICAN CUP FOR PROMOTIONAL CLUBS IN SHOW AND PRECISION ARTISTIC SKATING.

PARAGRAPH 1 - This club event will compete with the technical regulations contemplated in the World Skate America Artistic 2025 regulations for Show and Precision of Promotional Clubs, to be published on the website.

PARAGRAPH 2 - For these disciplines, a skater may compete in a maximum of two (2) categories during the same competition. Refer to rule 2.3 of the World Skate General Regulations for 2025

PARAGRAPH 3 - Athletes who participated in a prior World championship in a discipline are eligible to participate in a different discipline in this championship.

ARTICLE 2 – CATEGORIES, RULES AND DISCIPLINES

PARAGRAPH 1 – CATEGORIES

World Skate America promotional Categories and regulations for Show and Precision in force for the year 2025 will be used.

PARAGRAPH 2 – DISCIPLINES

For this event, show and precision disciplines will be competed.

ARTICLE 3 – DATES AND VENUE:

The event will be held at Microestadio de Patinaje CAP, pabellón Europa located at Parque Olímpico de la Juventud, Buenos Aires, Argentina on July 6th, 2025. These dates may change one day, before or after, the stipulated dates depending on the number of skaters registered.

ARTICLE 4 - ORGANIZATION

World Skate America and the Argentinean Skating Confederation will be responsible for organizing the event in administrative and logistical aspects and the WSA Artistic Technical Committee will be responsible for the technical sports aspects.

ARTICLE 5 - PARTICIPANTS

Athletes from clubs, leagues, teams or associations from WSA member countries are eligible to participate.

ARTICLE 6 – REGISTRATION QUOTA

ATHLETES:

Maximum five (5) groups can be registered per club by discipline and category.

SUPPORT PERSONNEL:

Each federation may register up to two (2) coaches and one (1) delegate included in its registration per country. Additional coaches and/or delegates may register at an extra cost.

PARAGRAPH 1. The accreditations of coaches and delegates registered for national events will be valid exclusively for the event in which they participate. In each event the corresponding accreditation will be required.

ARTICLE 7 – SANCTIONS AND TRANSITIONAL DISABILITY

The Confederation and/or Federation that registers athletes, who do not appear at the event or who, being registered, do not appear for a specific event, will be sanctioned, or disqualified as stipulated by the WSA.

Payment of the penalty is essential for this federation to regain the right to participate in another competition.

PARAGRAPH 1 Athletes, Confederations and/or clubs, leagues, associations or teams will be exempt from the penalty described in this article if:

- Present documentation accredited by an official doctor verified by the Federation to which you belong.
- For reasons of force majeure, verified by the WSA Artistic Skating Technical Committee and authorized by the WSA president.

PARAGRAPH 2 In the event that an organization or athlete is exempt from the established disabilities, it is not exonerated from the payment of the financial obligations acquired with the organization and the WSA, corresponding to the registration of the athlete and/or federation to the event, according to the case.

PARAGRAPH 3 Athletes and/or clubs, leagues, associations or teams that incur any of the disabilities written in this article, will have three (3) calendar days following the event, to present in writing the reasons they had to justify their non-attendance at the event. event, with the respective proofs to the email inscripcionesartistico@worldskateamerica.org

ARTICLE 8 – AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the athletes, couples or groups who occupy the first four places in each event, by gender and discipline, as follows: 1 gold, 1 silver and 2 bronzes.

ARTICLE 9 – DRAWS AND SKATING ORDER

The skating order will be drawn electronically and will be published in advance for review and correction prior to the technical meeting.

ARTICLE 10 – PROGRAM TECHNICAL DOCUMENTS AND MUSIC FILES

PARAGRAPH 1 – Once the registration form has been received, a folder to upload the documents and music of the programs will be shared. If this information is not uploaded by the deadline date, the registration will be charged as an extraordinary.

PARAGRAPH 2 – The files must be uploaded for each group using the parameters described in the World Skate regulations according to formats, quality and file names.

PARAGRAPH 3 – The following files must be uploaded for all groups:

- The music files for each program.
- The technical content sheets for each program.
- For Show discipline, program description.

ARTICLE 11 – REGISTRATIONS

Registration must be sent according to the dates established in this article by email at inscripcionesartistico@worldskateamerica.org

The template published on the World Skate America page must be used, without converting to PDF or image. Different formats will not be taken into account.

PARAGRAPH 1 The ORIGINAL form, duly signed by the Federation or Confederation, must be presented on the day of accreditation. Without this document, accreditation cannot be carried out. Incomplete registrations submitted in a different format will be considered not received.

PARAGRAPH 2 The national team that is not represented at the information meeting, by its delegate duly accredited to the WSA, will not be able to make claims at the event.

ARTICLE 12 – REGISTRATION FEES

PARAGRAPH 1 The sum of the Championship registrations must be paid in cash in US dollars, by the respective delegate before entering the event information meeting (according to detailed programming to be published).

PARAGRAPH 2 - In order for athletes from a country to participate in the Pan American Nations Championship regardless of their individual participation, it is required that the Federation and/or Confederation to which they belong is in good standing in all respects with World Skate America.

ARTICLE 13 – CLAIMS

World Skate rules will be followed.

ARTICLE 14 – AUTHORITIES OF THE EVENT

- The highest authority in the technical direction of the event will be in charge of the person designated by the president of World Skate America.
- The highest judging authority will be the technical officials.

- The highest disciplinary authority will be the Disciplinary Commission of the event, which will be made up of the referee judge of the event, one of the delegates of the Pan American commission present and a representative designated by the Federation Hosting the event.
- The highest administrative authority will be the Steering Committee of the event, headed by the president of World Skate America.

ARTICLE 15 – EVENT MODIFICATION OR CANCELLATION

Only the World Skate America Artistic Skating Technical Committee may modify or cancel a certain event that does not comply with the conditions of the competition, due to space on the stage, lack of time, competitive level, guarantees, or due to unforeseen delays in the programming.

ARTICLE 16 – CLUBS MEETING

The event information meeting will take place at the place and time that the event organization provides for this purpose, and which will be announced in the official invitation. For this meeting, the presence of all the coaches who are registered on the respective rosters and the judges who have been summoned is requested.

PARAGRAPH 1 Once the Nations meeting is concluded, the judges' meeting will be held in the same room.

ARTICLE 17 – RESPONSIBILITY IN ACCIDENTS

World Skate America and The Argentinean Skating Confederation are not responsible for accidents that may occur during the event, which is why all skaters must have current medical and/or accident insurance, ORIGINAL documents that must be presented at the time of the events respective accreditations.

ARTICLE 18 – VALIDITY

This resolution is effective from the date of its issuance. Given in the city of Buenos Aires, on March 6th, 2025.
